## Theme: Mission World Market

The Indian Foundry Industry is the backbone of the engineering industry which contributes significantly to India's GDP and exports. It is globally the second largest.

India produces 11.0 million ton of castings valued at USD 19.0 billion and exports castings worth USD 2.7 billion. USA is the third largest producer at 9.0 million ton, but revenue wise it is approximately USD 30.0 billion. India's share of export of castings, globally, is less than 2%, which can be substantially enhanced by suitable support and enabling interventions.

A large number of Indian foundries are technically competent, but are handicapped (specially the SMEs) as they face the challenge of access to modern technologies and design and manufacturing tools. These foundries can become export worthy and help India achieve a significant share in global markets.

In keeping with the theme of the Congress, MISSION: WORLD MARKET, the 67th IFC will address the various challenging issues facing Indian foundries such as product development, response time, value-addition, productivity, compliance with international standards and norms, consistency in quality and cost-competitiveness and highlight the use of modern technology, optimum resource management, recycling and continuous training of workforce as the antidote. This will surely help India improve its global market share.

## Conference venue

### India Expo Centre and Mart

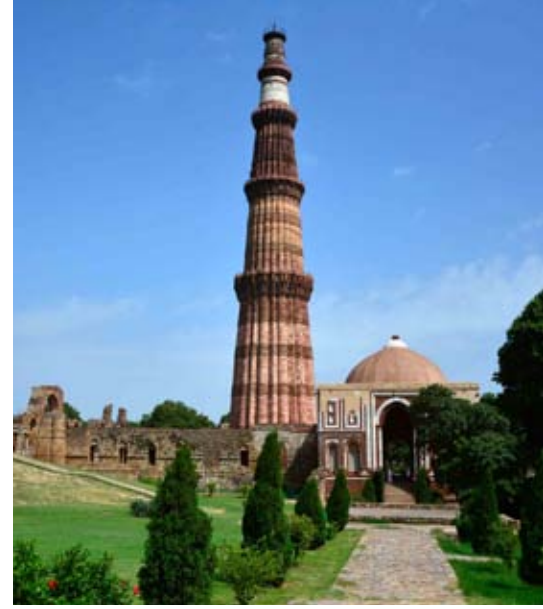
